NO SMOKING POLICY

It is the Playschools policy that the setting is smoke free and that all children, employees and visitors have a right to be in a smoke free environment and not be exposed to second-hand smoke. This is also a statutory requirement.

The settings policy on smoking applies not only to employees but also to parents, carers and visitors.

Appropriate no smoking signs are clearly displayed around the setting.

If a person does not comply with this policy, they will be warned that they are committing an offence, requested to immediately refrain from smoking and, if they refuse, they will be asked to leave the premises.

Those who do not comply with the smoking ban are also liable to a fixed penalty fine and possible criminal prosecution.
